requires a multi-agency approach and increased partnership working. Working in this way can increase identification of domestic violence and reduce both the proportion of repeat incidents and the impact on those experiencing domestic violence. It improves the outcomes in the three main areas of prevention, protection and support.

Domestic Violence Champions are able to proactively draw together the agencies who can provide prevention, protection and support services and instrumental in mainstreaming domestic violence.

The role will be part of your current job and you will need the support of your line manager.

This leaflet sets out your responsibilities as a Champion and also what support you will receive from us.

Role and Support

You will be the domestic violence and abuse specialist for your organisation or service area.

You will be the link between your organisation or service area.

You will keep yourself up to date on domestic violence and abuse issues.

You will help support the domestic violence and abuse strategy.

You will come to at least two Champions meetings a year and be a member of your local forum.

You will cascade information and provide training about domestic violence to your organisation or service area.

You will be able to go to regular Champions meetings where you can network with other Champions, get updates and further training.

You get training from the domestic abuse and violence training programme at a reduced rate

You will get a regular Newsletter and updates.

You will get support from the Domestic Abuse Coordinator.

You will have a role that you know will make a difference.
